### Continuity of Operations

The University of Central Florida's (UCF) mission is to offer high quality undergraduate and graduate education, student development, and continuing education; to conduct research and creative activities; and to provide services that enhance the intellectual, cultural, environmental, and economic development of the metropolitan region, address national and international issues in key areas, establish UCF as a major presence, and contribute to the global community.

Florida Statute 252.365 requires UCF to create and maintain a disaster-preparedness plan that must be submitted annually for approval by the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM). To accomplish this mission, the university must ensure its Continuity of Operations (COOP) and Continuity of Government (COG) are performed efficiently with minimal disruption, especially during an emergency.

The COOP document provides planning and program guidance for implementing the UCF COOP and COG Plan and programs to ensure the University is capable of conducting its essential missions and leadership functions under all conditions. While the severity and consequences of an emergency cannot be predicted, effective contingency planning can minimize the impact and disruption on the University's mission, leadership, personnel, and facilities.



While it is recommended all departments on campus have a COOP plan, FDEM has set requirements that determine what functions are deemed critical and are required to be included in the COOP document. UCF has also determined certain departments and functions to be critical to the operations of the University as defined in [UCF Policy 3117.1](#).
